

- All campus activities have stopped and the institution is completely closed.


Respondents'institutional role







How has your institution responded to the current outbreak?




- My institution has implemented no specific response plan and has no plans to develop one

- My institution has not yet implemented a specific response plan but is currently developing one


Almost 96% of institutions which responded are either developing a plan or implementing one.






Do you allow international students to remain in residence for the rest of the semester




Impact of international mobility (IN and OUT) - Multiple answers





Do you currently provide students (OUT/IN) with registration letters/ supporting documents?




